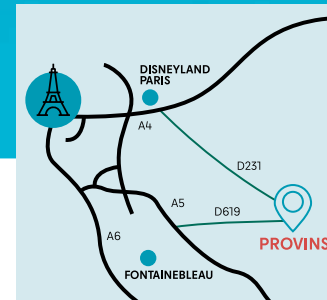
HOW TO GET TO PROVINS (77160)

Join the famous medieval ball, followed by the grand concert on Saturday evening, for a truly festive experience!



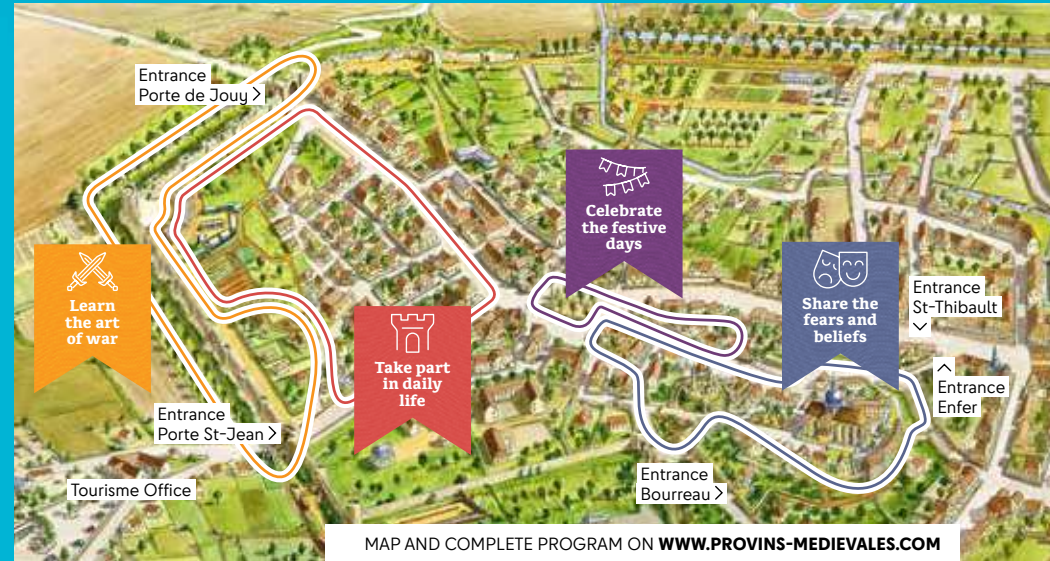
TAKE PART IN DAILY LIFE
